Following your request to ICAR enquiring if ICAR has granted a manufacturer the code 911, we checked our database and can inform you that as of 07th November 2016, no manufacturer has been granted the code 911 under the Registration Agreement between ISO¹ and ICAR. This effectively means that tags with the manufacturer code 911 have not heretofore been verified by ICAR to be compliant with the ISO 11784 and ISO 11785 standards².

Note 1. In 2007, ISO appointed ICAR as the Registration Authority (RA) competent to register manufacturer codes used in the radio frequency identification (RFID) of animals in accordance with ISO 11784 and ISO 11785.

Note 2. ISO 11785 defines the test protocols for evaluating and verifying both the conformance and performance of RFID devices and ISO11784 the code structure.
