1 Terms of Reference

1.1 Background

The purpose of this paper is to outline the terms of reference for the Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force following the decisions by the Interbull Steering Committee on _____ and the ICAR Board on 29th July to establish a Task Force. It was agreed "That a small Task Force be established, with representation from Interbull (2 or 3 persons) and ICAR (2 or 3 persons), to examine and consider synergies between the operations of the Interbull Centre, ICAR and Service-ICAR with a view to achieving greater efficiencies and effectiveness for all activities. The Task Force is to make recommendations to the ICAR Board and to the Interbull Steering Committee."

This report is for consideration by the ICAR Board at its 28th August meeting by telephone conference call and by the Interbul Steering Committee on _____.

The following sections cover the key elements of the Terms of Reference for the Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force.

1.2 Objectives of the Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force

The objectives of the Interball and ICAR Operations Task Force are to:

- a. Elaborate the bosiness processes of Interbull, ICAR and Service ICAR.
- b. Identify common and overlapping business processes.
- c. Evaluate options for achieving greater efficiency and effectiveness in common and overlapping business processes.
- d. Provide a report with recommendations to the Interbull Steering committee and the ICAR Board.

1.3 Governance

The **Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force** will be self-governed.

The **Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force** will comprise members appointment by the Interbull Steering Committee and ICAR Board who cover the following interests:

- a. **Interbull:** administration, funding, technical activities and services. Including relevant staff of the Interbull Centre, SLU.
- b. **ICAR:** administration, funding, technical activities and services. Including relevant member of the ICAR Executive Team.

a. The **Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force** will have secretarial support provided by a member of the ICAR Executive Team.

1.5 Communications with the ICAR Board and Interbull Steering Committee

- a. Interim reports as decided by the **Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force.**
- b. Final report on completion of work.

1.6 Priorities

That the priorities for Interbull and ICAR Operations Task Force are:

- a. To consider the overlap in the service role provided by Interbull and Service ICAR.
- b. To consider the potential benefits of a consolidated IT system for ICAR and Interbull based on the model developed by interbull.
- c. To consider the potential for achieving greater operational resilience to loss of key staff at the Interbull Centre and in the ICAR office.
