The Czech-Moravian Breeders' Corporation is responsible for managing the national animal identification system in the Czech Republic and maintains the national central animal register, records holding facilities, animals and animal movements nationally and labels and distributes the ear tags to the farmers. Ear tags from four manufacturers are used – all manufacturers are ISO- and / or CTIM-certified and the ear tags are tested and approved according to ICAR and / or Institut de Élevage and / or national guidelines. All the relevant procedures are in accordance to the applicable national and EU regulations and fully conform to the relevant ICAR Guidelines.

All weights for beef cattle production recording are taken according to Method A. 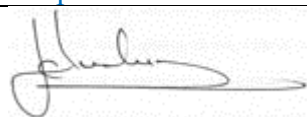
