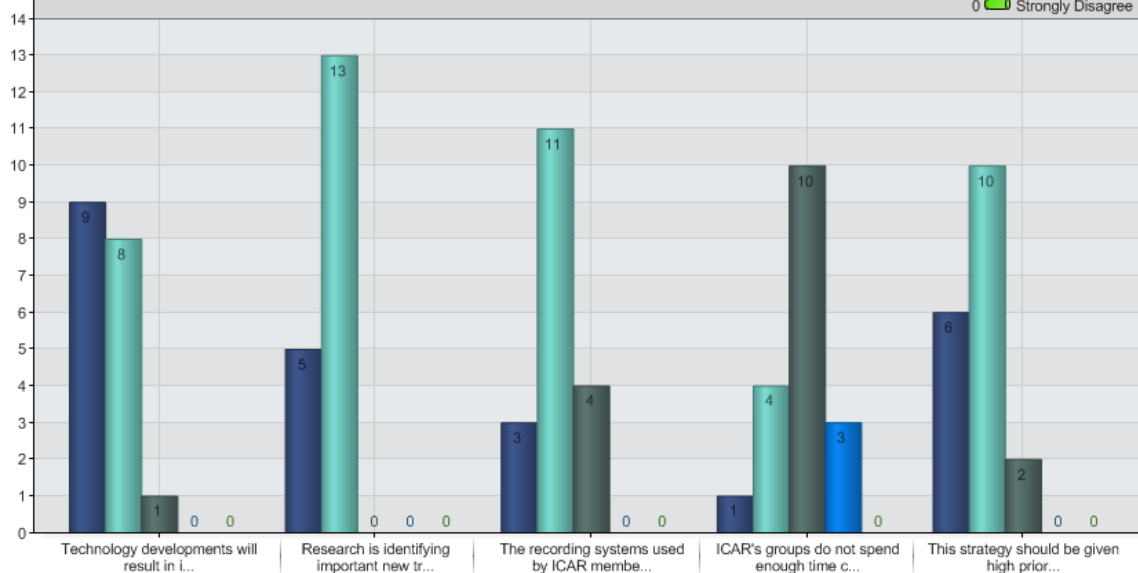

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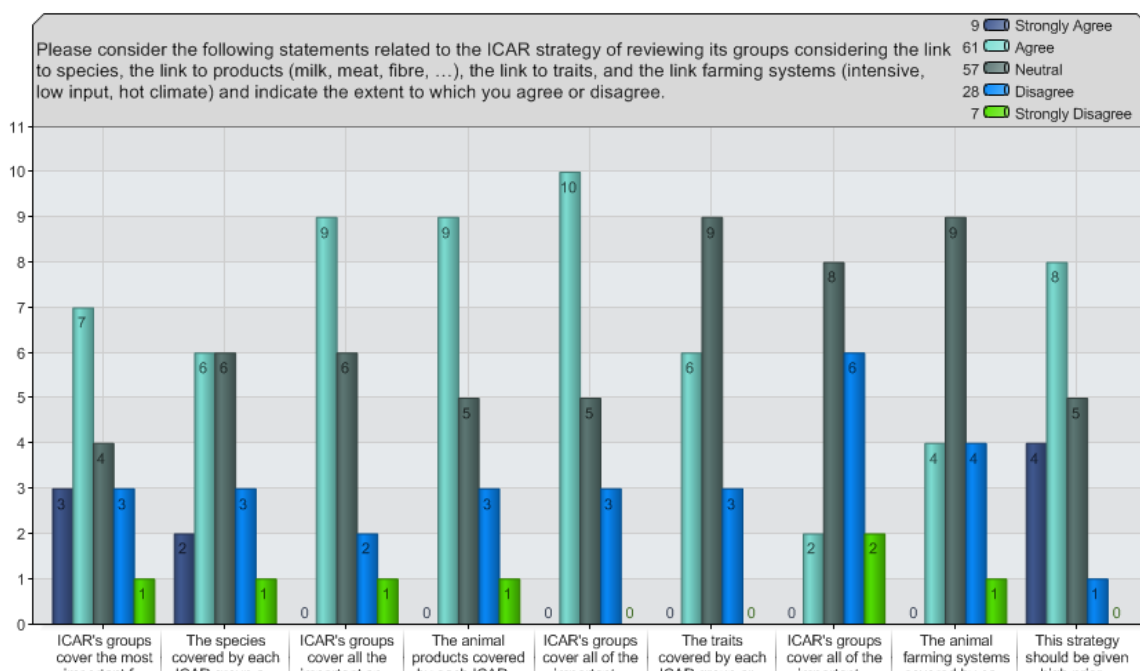

What comments or questions do you have on the ICAR strategy of *extending the scope of ICAR to better cover developments in recording devices, traits to be recorded and systems for animal recording*?

Response	Response Text
1	ICAR needs to be more pro-active and helping to ensure research is conducted to enable ICAR members to be well placed to quickly utilise new technologies and devices.
2	I see the big issue is how to cope with the new technology alongside traditional approaches particularly when the number initially may be very small. That is existing databases are setup to handle data in a particular way. To make changes to accommodate one (or many) new approaches may be complex and expensive and hard to justify (at a company, or national level).
3	Which approach to apply to identify the systems?
4	It is essential that ICAR better deals with new traits and new technologies. On the other hand, ICAR should help to identify the most relevant traits / new technologies to avoid the risk of being lost in a too large scope
5	The reaction to new technological developments will be a key issue for ICAR in the future. I feel the best approach is to be on the front foot and prepare any response in advance, before these technologies are implemented and without delay. In this context I think the ICAR Working Group should try to stimulate these developments and become an initiator of these changes.
6	I think ICAR needs to appreciate that additional data on new traits and measurements will be collected as part of an integrated system on the farm. They may be different sources of data that are stored on central on-farm computer. The goal is two-fold: 1. identify and verify that the data is credible (approved devices, etc) and 2. merging the data into usable format (standard trait definitions, reduce noise, and accept that missing data is acceptable and possibly preferred over bad data.
7	Standardisation and data exchange should be made easier between different technologies on-farm, but data from e.g. sensors,... should also be comparable between products,...
8	I think the extension of ICAR's scope to cover new developments is critical for the maintenance of ICAR's relevancy on the global platform.

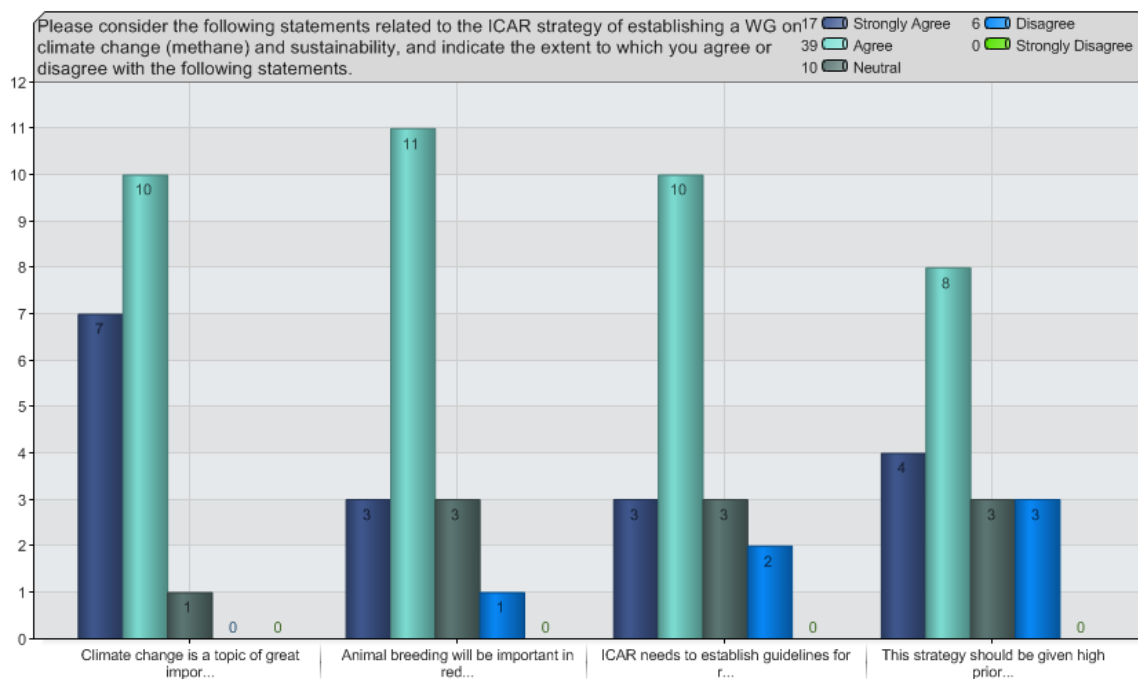

1	Pigs? Poultry?
2	ICAR does not cover pigs and poultry. It covers milking cows in the western world very well but does not cover low input system or animals on extreme climates. A clearer structure and relationship between groups, species, products and production systems is needed.
3	Fiber ? Buffalo ? Asia area and production systems ?
4	It would be interesting that a specific group cover meat sheep, as meat sheep is an important production in Europe and South Hemisphere as well.
5	I think there's a missing point in the ICAR Guidelines, which pertains to meat performance recording in sheep and goats. Sheep-related performance recording is especially important, as it is more common than dairy performance. It seems feasible to prepare the Guidelines with these areas in mind.
6	Farm animals include pigs and poultry, so if the questio would have about eg ruminants the answers would have been different
7	I think we need to be very careful about using statements such as "all the important" as the importance of a product or species is often uniquely specific to a country or community.

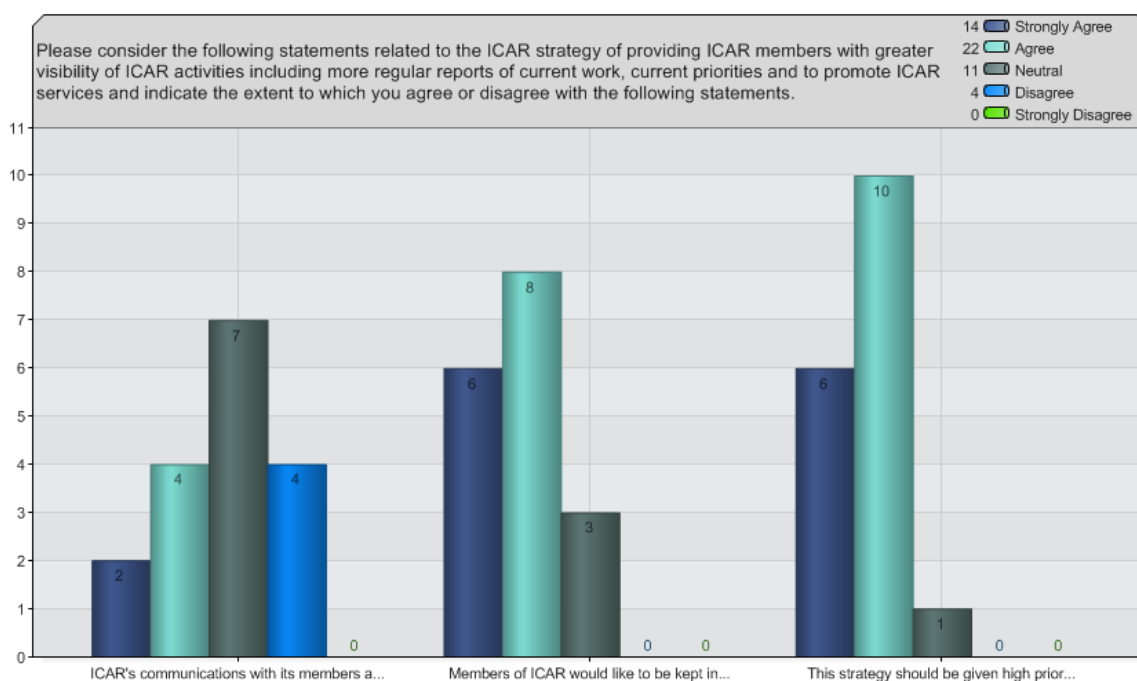

1	This is an example of a new threat and set of technologies where ICAR should be much more pro-active.
2	This topic is to be tackled, but maybe not in a high priority.
3	Concerning methane, we can deal with this issue. The Guidelines can be created but it seems there is a lack of interest because farmers do not get the direct benefit from this approach.

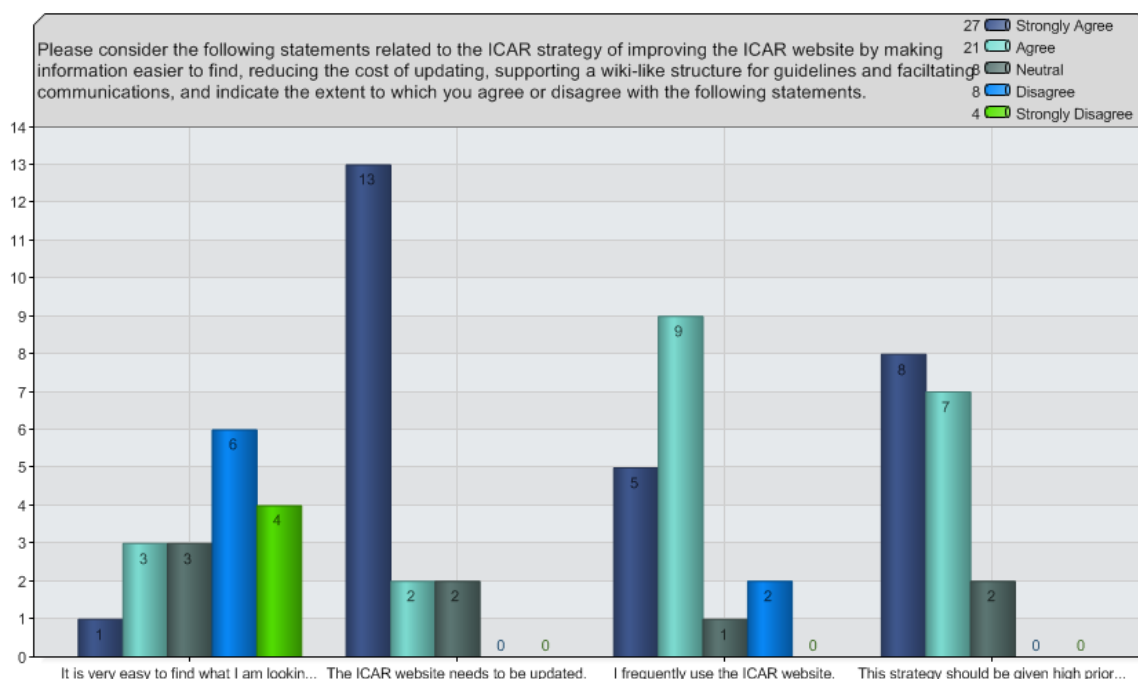

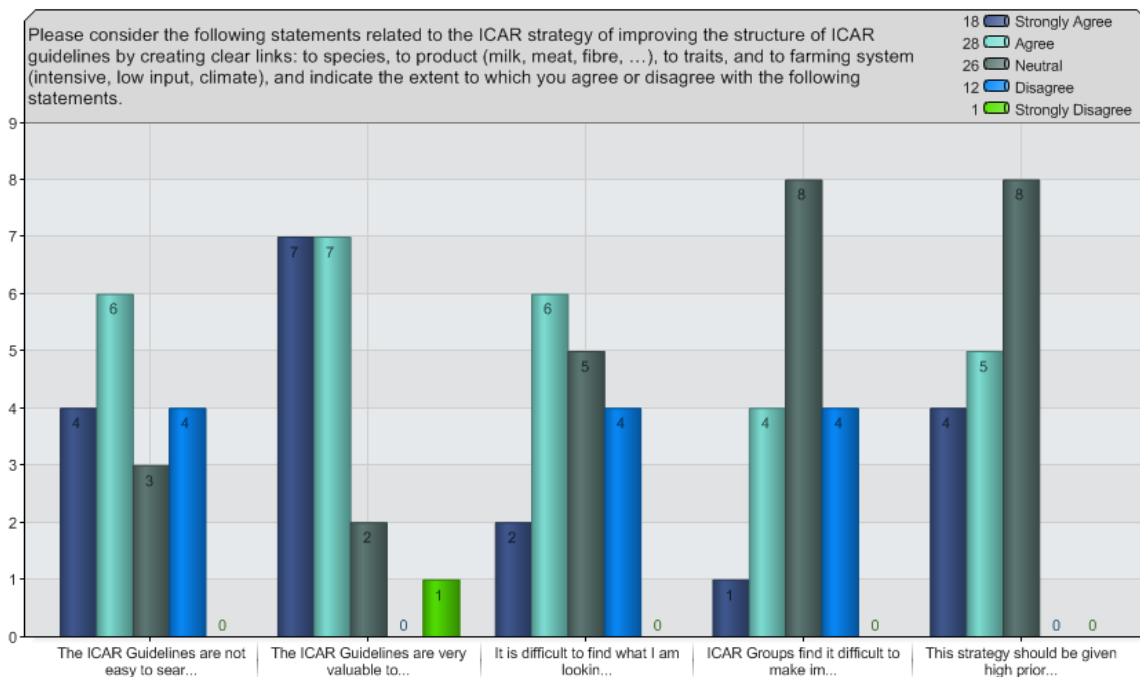
