### 4.4 New Quarterly Financial Reporting Templates

The existing Board Financial Reports of Balance Sheet and P&L have been reviewed and endorsed by Deloitte. They say these are in line with International Standards. We will continue to use these as is but will now make available Quarterly Reports to Board(s).

#### 8.1 Milk Analysis SC

Results of the September 2016 PT were distributed first week of October with some 41 laboratories participating from all 5 continents.

# 8.2 Animal Data Exchange (ADE)

A comprehensive review of the ADE work was conducted by Brian Wickham and the ADE Group. This involved phone conferences, stakeholders' surveys and a face to face meeting in September in Arnhem. The findings were compiled into a 9 page Report which an extracted summary is below. The Groups Coordinator and CE recommend to the Board we proceed with the recommendations in the report.

### 2 Summary

At the end of 2015, a first version of the standards for data exchange between central data base and on farm data collection systems, so called Animal Data Exchange (ADE) was issued in order to start pilot implementations with three manufacturers, DELAVAL, FULLWOOD, and LELY, in France, Germany and in the Netherlands.

The pilot implementations were cancelled, so the working group decided to slow its activity, and to analyse the need for its efforts on behalf of ICAR's members.

We conducted a survey which confirmed the importance of international standards and the commitment of ICAR in the field a data exchange. It also confirmed the ICAR standards meets the most frequent needs of ICAR members.

We recommend:

- That ADE WG should continue its work.
- The ICAR guidelines for data exchange should now be updated based on work undertaken by the ADE WG.
- That over the next two years the priority of the ADE WG will be to complete a pilot ADE implementation in collaboration with those manufacturers and ICAR members who have expressed a willingness to participate.

### 8.3 Animal Identification SC

The CE requested Australian representation from our full member NLIS to join the SC ID. They nominated a Jo(anne) Quigley. Jo is the Chief Operating Officer of the newly formed Integrity and Information System Company, which is a subsidiary of Meat and Livestock Australia. This new entity encompasses the operation of Australia's NLIS, plus additional integrity systems. NLIS Ltd becomes part of the new company.

The SC have been circulated about the nomination. The CE recommends to adopt and accept this new member for the ID SC.

#### 8.4 Sheep & Goat

We are in the process of appointing members to the three associated Expert Advisory Groups (EAGs) which advise the new 'umbrella' group of Sheep, Goat & Camelid (SGC WG).

Our proposal is that the WG will comprise Jean-Michel plus the chairs of the three EAGs. Our proposal to the ICAR Board is that Jean-Michel Astruc will Chair this new Working Group. Jean-Michel has agreed to undertake this role. We ask the Board to sanction Jean Michel's Chairmanship
