Finally he is well known in the sector as a good hearted man with a natural attitude in building lasting human relationships with collaborators at national and international level.

We really believe that the involvement of dr. Santus with breeds other than Holstein and with species other than bovines could provide ICAR additional competences and links with a food production systems that are becoming more complex and adapted to local needs.
