

Data Recording

- "Viehverkehrsordnung" § 23 (regulation on animal trading)
 - prevention of epidemic diseases
 - professional hooftrimmers have to record
 - address of farm
 - date of trimming
 - store these information for 3 years
 - further recording (voluntary)
 - problems (see below)












Recording

- hoof trimmers in Germany
 - Verein geprüfter Klauenpfleger
 - 66 licensed trimmers (< 30 % collect data)
 - Klauenpfleger-Genossenschaft Sachsen
 - 43 licensed trimmers (all of them collect data)
 - VKKD
 - German Agricultural Society (www.dlg.org)
 - 60 registered trimmers (licensed and not licensed)
- cows in Germany
 - 4.22 Mio



Recording

- survey (VgK)
 - 66 licensed trimmers (< 30 % recording)
 - 15 x feedback
- recording
 - 12 yes, 3 no (farmer)
- how do you record?
 - written on paper only: 2
 - paper and electronic recording: 2
 - electronic recording: 11
 - own program: 1
 - commercially available program: 10 (dsp agrosoft, "Klaue")
- farms and animals
 - 20 200 herds / trimmer
 - 400 (since May 14) 500,000 cows ; average: 15,000 / year / trimmer

Recording

- problems
 - no computer skills keep it simple
 - price (program > 1000 €, computer > 2/3000 €)



Recording

- problems
 - no computer skills
 - price (program > 1000 €, computer > 2/3000 €)
 - For whom should I record? Who is the owner of the data? Who can use the data?
 - farmer or trimmer
 - companies (breeding, provider of programs)
 - time for recording (paid by ???)
 - charge per animal (0,80 ct)
 - charge trimming per hour

Future

- Pro Gesund (pro health) (supported by Ministry of Agriculture, central database)
 - monitoring all data on health
 - to advise farmers (management)
 - data for breeding (in future)
- Deutscher Verband für Leistungs- und Qualitätsprüfungen e.V. (DLQ)
 - milk recording and animal health recording
 - Hoof Health Project
